**DISCLAIMER:** The admission averages listed are specific to the fall 2026 intake for students admitted through the early admission or standard admission processes for the purpose of finalizing an offer of admission. To **finalize admission**, students must successfully complete all [30-level course requirements](#) (or equivalent), ensure their final average does not drop more than 3-5% (program dependent) below the admission average listed for finalizing offers of admission and obtain their Alberta Grade 12 Graduation (or equivalent) by the end of June.

Students admitted with a lower admission average, including through the Indigenous Admission Process and the Student Access Process, are expected to maintain their admission average and ensure their final average does not drop more than 3%.

\*Students admitted to the Bachelor of Science in Nursing through the lottery process must maintain an average at or above 82% to finalize admission.
